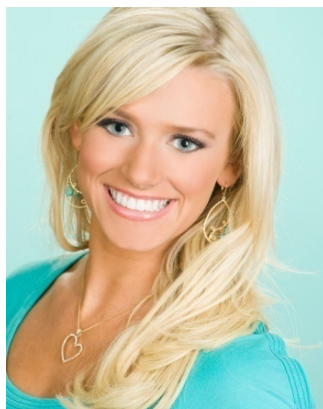
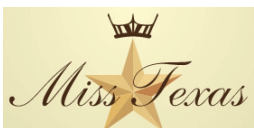

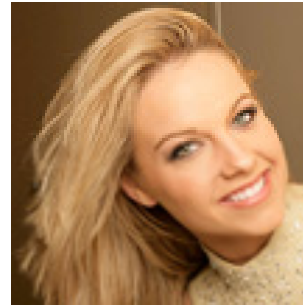
RON CARTER, Creative Director
